4 Steps to go

Let's rock

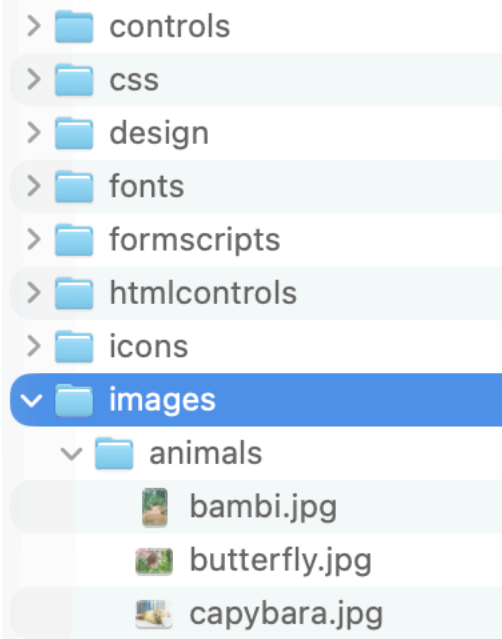


1. Copy all pictures into the HTML/pictures folder.
2. Display the pictures in a Tile Grid control.
3. Provide a detailed view in a separate remote from for each individual picture.
4. Open the detail form from the Tile Grid control as a Subform Palette.

Step 1

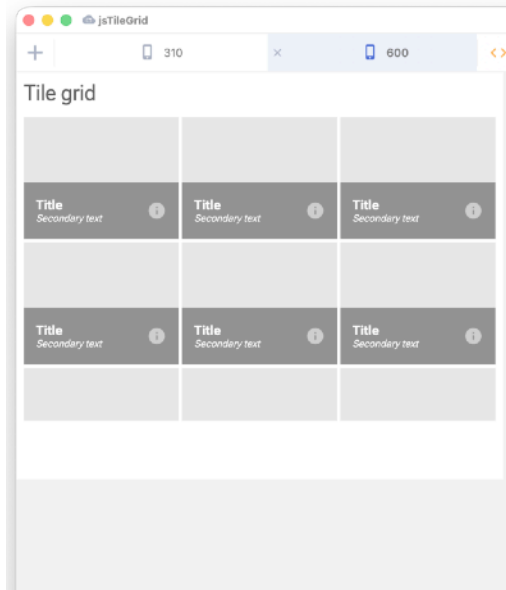
Copy all pictures

1. Copy all pictures into the HTML/pictures folder.



Step 2

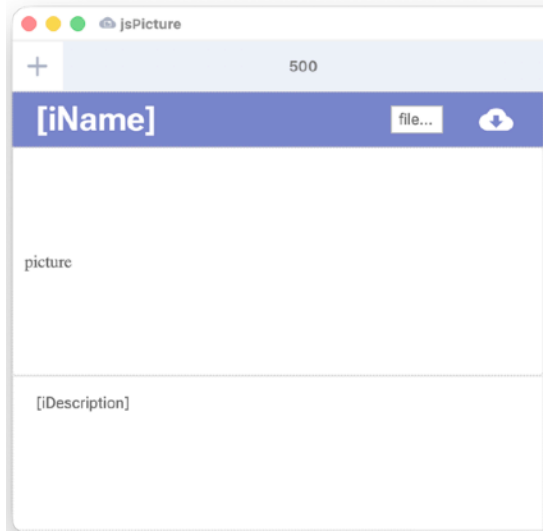
Display the pictures in a Tile Grid control.



1. Create a remote form with a tile control
2. Make a list of all pictures in the right format for the tile control.
3. Load all the picture data into the list

Step 3

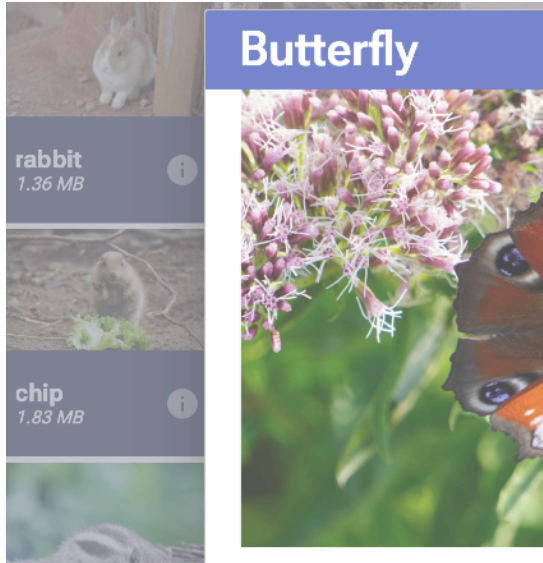
Provide a detailed view in a separate remote form



1. Create a remote form with a picture control and a title.
2. Prepare the picture URL and the name of the picture as a title from given parameters in its \$construct.
3. Set the picture properties to display the picture in a scaled format.

Step 4

Open the detail form from the Tile Grid



1. In the tile grids \$event method calculate the two parameters
2. Then use the client command "subformpaletteshow" to open the detail form using the parameterstring.
