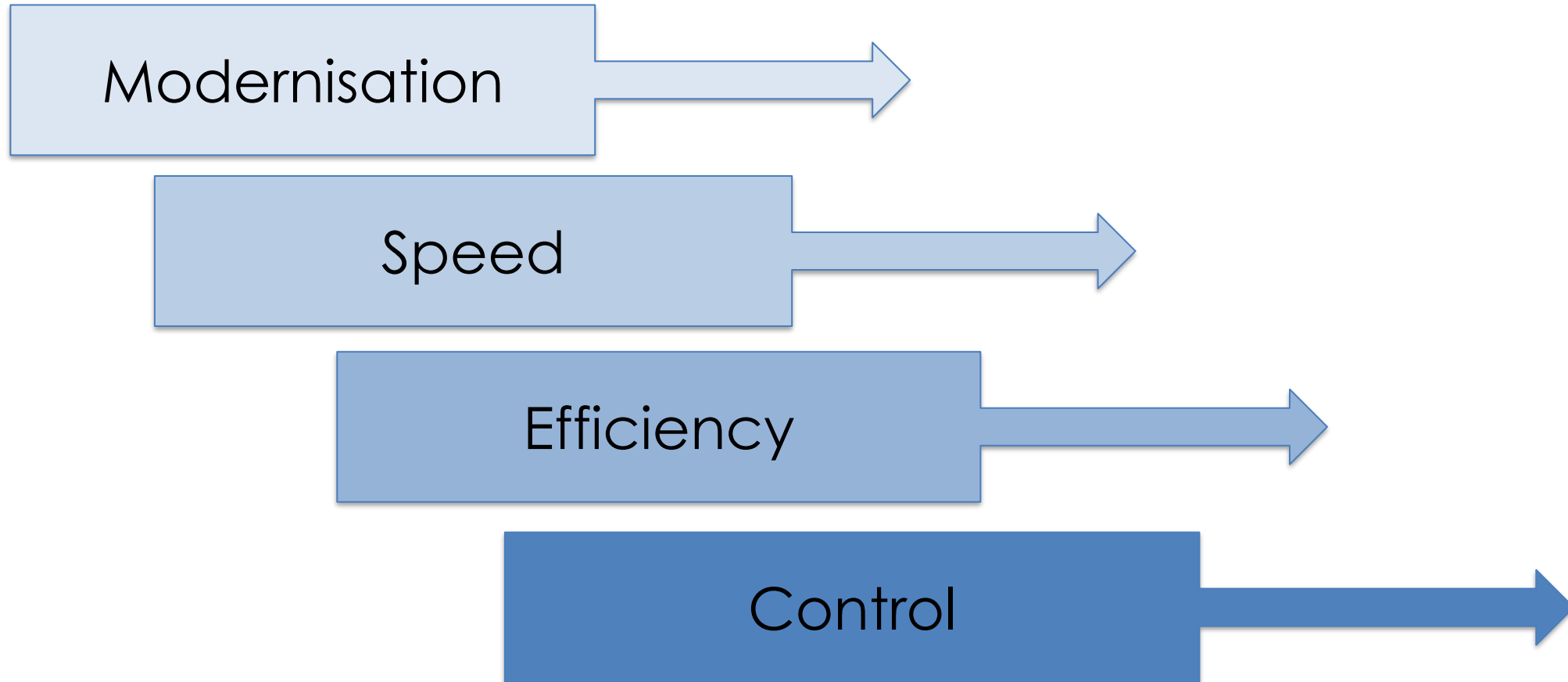

# Why Changes in Omnis Studio Licensing?

## Our Targets

- **Faster innovation**  
Constant flow of new features, enhancements, fixes  
Allows us to deliver new features activated through the license
- **Increased efficiency**  
Dynamic updating of licenses without re-deployment  
Run out of runtimes or need more web users? No problem & no rebuilding or deploying!
- **Less admin**  
No more processing, administration and handling of thousands of serial numbers
- **Better planning**  
By activation statistics  
Gives early warnings of activation use allowing you to scale licenses early
- **More control**  
Of your staff licenses and your end user/customers licenses  
Detailed information of who is using your applications

# What Will Change?

## Everything & Nothing

### Everything...

- Switch to a Subscription licensing model  
(or alternatively lifetime licenses with mandatory maintenance)
- The old style serial numbers end with Studio v11.2
- New streamlined processes
  - updating of licensing without re-deployment
  - management of your licenses at one central place)
- Activation of licenses

### Nothing...

- No pricing changes
- For customers on ODPP & Maintenance, no relevant changes
- Studio Now becomes Studio 12
- Individual use cases & exceptions can be grandfathered

# Omnis ID

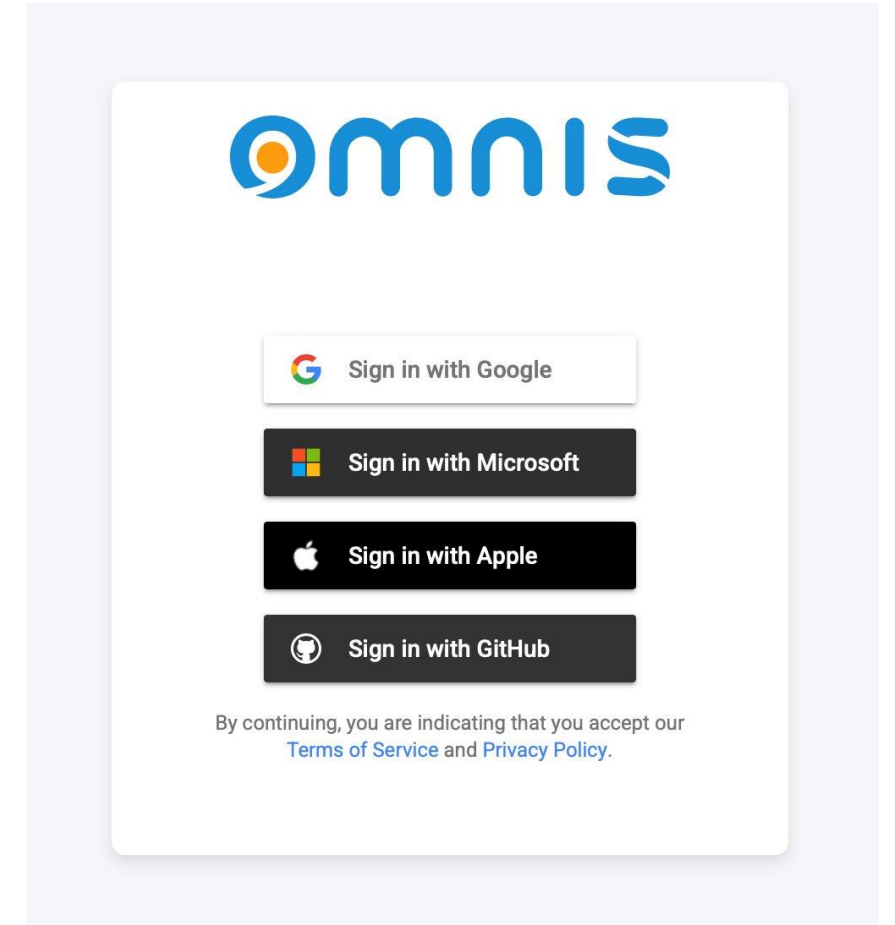
## Your central Hub for Omnis Services

- Omnis ID is your new central [hub](#) for managing, activating, sharing and purchasing of Omnis licenses.
- Omnis ID is a [centralised authentication system](#) which provides secure, seamless user authentication across all Omnis services.
- It integrates with [Firebase Authentication](#) for initial user identity verification and adds a second layer of authentication by issuing a signed Omnis ID token managed via a secure HTTP-only domain cookie.
- This system ensures both [high security](#) and [ease of use](#) across multiple Omnis domains and services.

- New customers will receive a link from Sales with the order to click and create an Omnis ID account that will then receive the license.

# Purchasing a Studio License

## How does it work?

As you like...

### a) Online Store

Using the Omnis Online Store, you will be prompted to create or login to your [OMNIS ID](#) account.

The new license will be created in your account.

### b) Sales

If contacting Omnis Sales directly, sales will create an order for your company.

Existing customers/businesses owners with an [OmnisID](#) account will have the new license added to their accounts.


# The Omnis ID Dashboard

## How does it work?

Using the Omnis ID dashboard you will be able to:

- Monitor your licenses & activations via charts & visuals
- Share licenses with your employees
- Deactivate older activations in an existing license.
- Provision license tickets for runtime & server for deployment
- Provision license files for locations with no internet access

>> In the Dashboard we can add new feature options to existing licenses – this removes the need for customers to manually update or change the license


# License Sharing

## Company-wide License Control

- Company owners with [multiple developers](#) can monitor and distribute licenses to their employees via the Omnis ID Dashboard.
- Owners can purchase a license via the Online Store/Omnis Sales using their own Omnis ID.
- To share a license, owners using the dashboard can select a free license and [create a share link](#).
- Send this link to your employee.
- The employee can click the link, create or sign in to [her/his Omnis ID](#) account and accepts the license.
- The license can now be used by the developer using [her/his Omnis ID](#).



# Activation

## Developer Licenses

Activation of a Developer License is a simple **3 stage process**:

1. On the Welcome screen, [sign in](#) to your Omnis ID account,
2. There [select a license](#) with available activations & confirm the EULA,
3. Then [activate & use](#)

*Please note:* A developer license is for one developer and tied to the Omnis ID. This sole developer is permitted 5 individual installs & activations of Omnis. One developer license covers all versions.

*The number of installations per developer is subject to change & defined in the EULA.*

# Activation

## Desktop & Server Tickets

- An [activation ticket](#) is a signed file, created from the dashboard and associated with a license.
- The ticket is added to the license folder in the deployment tree.  
The ticket is exchanged for a license activation at runtime.
- Available for [desktop user licenses](#) and [server licenses](#)

# Activation

## Tickets


Use the Dashboard to create an activation ticket.

Add the ticket to the deployment tree.

On startup, a ticket is exchanged for an activation.

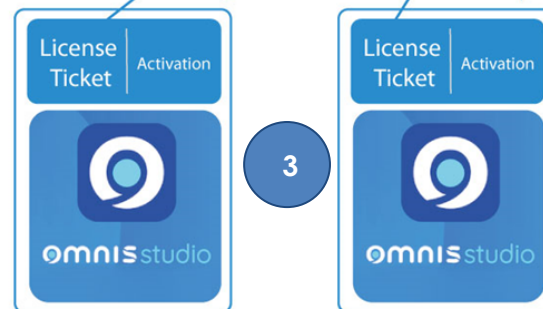
The dashboard can monitor activations.

The license can be upgraded if more activations are required.

# Offline Activation

## Payloads

To install Omnis in an [offline situation](#), you will need to create a [provisioned activated license](#) file from the dashboard.

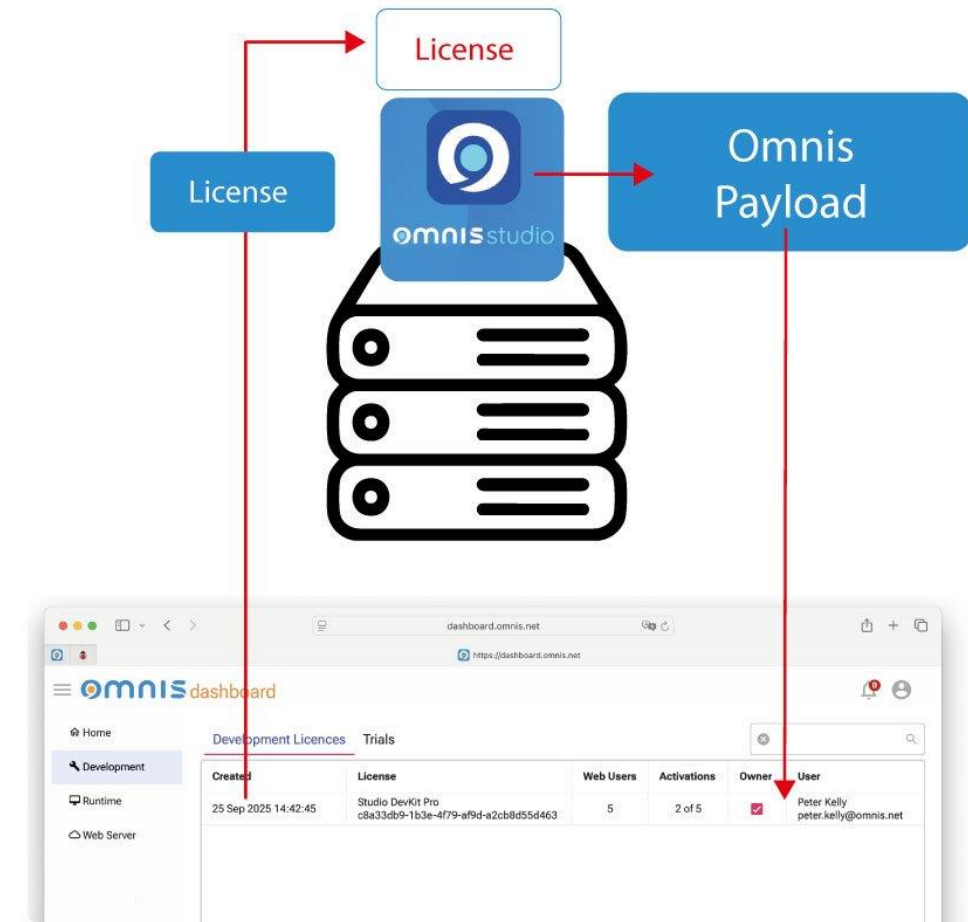
This license file can then be added to your [license folder](#).

You will need a [payload](#) from Omnis from the [target machine](#).

This payload can be used in the dashboard to create an [activated license for use only on the target machine](#).

Creating an activated license [consumes an activation](#).

Omnis will offer a number of simple ways to [collect the payload](#).



# License Leasing Server

## What is it?

The License Leasing Server (LLS) is used in scenarios where Omnis Studio runtimes or servers **cannot or must not communicate directly with third parties** such as Omnis Software to obtain a license.

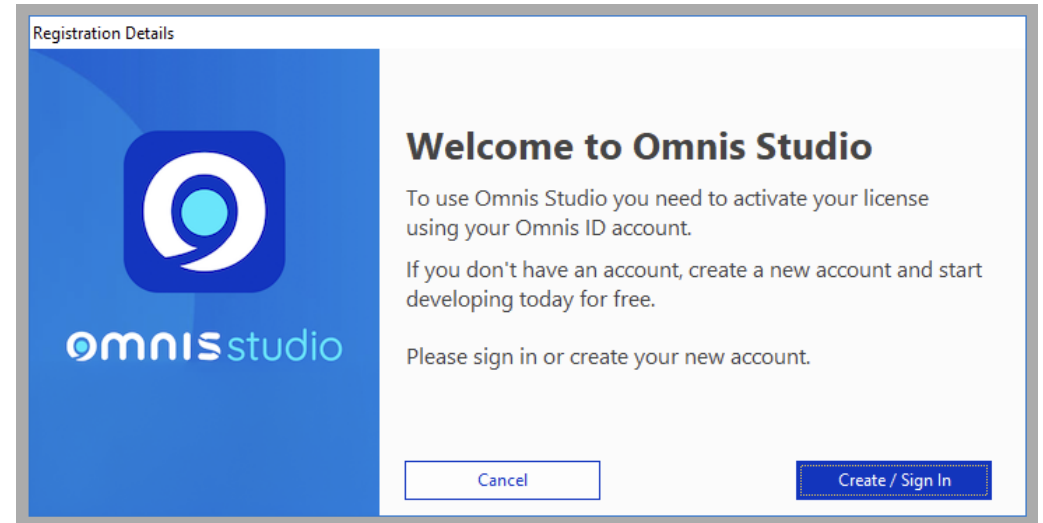
The LLS operates by obtaining a Leasing Authorisation (LA) from the Simple Licensing System (SLS) after submitting an identifier for the machine on which the LLS will run.

A **Leasing Authorisation (LA)** is a root-signed authorisation issued by SLS that binds a specific machine to a specific license and defines all permitted features and limits.
